Counter Height




Measure the height of the space under the counter. Be sure to measure in each corner of the installation space.

Floor Depth



If you have any plumbing or electrical obstacles in the installation space, make sure to measure the depth to the nearest obstacle.

Install Width



Measure the width of the install space three times; top, middle and bottom.

Install Height



Measure from the bottom of the countertop to the floor in front of the dishwasher. This will account for any new flooring that has been installed.

Nearest Obstacle



Measure the distance to the nearest obstacle.

Exterior Doorway



Measure the width of exterior doorways to ensure the appliance will get through.

Interior Doorway



Measure all interior doorways along the path to the install site. Write down the narrowest passage width.

Stairway Width



If the dishwasher is going upstairs, measure the width of the stairway in multiple places, taking into account the handrails.
