



Measure the depth of the area on each side of where the washer and dryer will reside.



Measure the height of the space from the floor to the cabinet above on both sides if applicable. This measurement is critical especially if you desire optional pedestals for front-load machines.



Measure the width of the space from any obstruction on the left to any obstruction on the right. Measure both top and bottom of the area.



Is your laundry area enclosed in a closet-like area? The doors may restrict the available depth to your new washer and dryer.



Measure the width of exterior doorways to ensure the appliance will get through.



Measure all interior doorways along the path to the install site. Write down the narrowest passage width.



If the washer and dryer is going upstairs, measure the width of the stairway in multiple places, taking into account the handrails.
